Mount Grace will be conducting a sustainable timber harvest, accompanied by forestry tours, this winter at our Arthur Iversen Conservation Area in Warwick.

The Arthur Iversen Conservation Area is a 517-acre woodland owned and managed by Mount Grace since in 1991. Following the wishes of the late Myra Iversen, who donated the land to Mount Grace, 94 acres were set aside for sustainable forest management purposes.
