ARTICLE 3: Shall the Town raise and appropriate \$832,500 for the Pioneer Regional School District FY20 assessment, or take other action related thereto?

ARTICLE 4: Shall the Town transfer from the Stabilization Fund the sum of \$5,000 to provide for purchase of a used police cruiser; or take any other action related thereto? (2/3 vote required)

ARTICLE 5: Shall the Town transfer from the Stabilization Fund the sum of \$8,000 to provide for school planning assistance; or take any other action related thereto? (2/3 vote required)
