First Parish and Religious Society of Warwick:

Prominent in early Town history, Warwick's Unitarian meeting house no longer hosts regular services. The Town Clock, manufactured by E. Howard & Co. in Boston and donated by the Clapp family in 1884, is housed in its tower, and by permission of the Parish Committee (see page 9), the beautiful building, erected in 1835, still sees occasional use by visiting congregations and wedding parties, and for Memorial Day ceremonies.
